Air Freight - Prohibited Items TRANSI



In compliance with the Civil Aviation Authority the below list of items **must not be packed** in an air freight consignment under any circumstances. If these items are included, the shipments must be returned from the airport, unpacked, repacked and can cause a delay in forwarding and additional charges.

The items listed are to do with air safety and not goods prohibited by a Customs or Quarantine Authority from the country you are moving to.

It is the responsibility of the owner to make sure none of the below is included in the airfreight.

- All electronics
- Laptops (even with batteries removed)
- Batteries (all types of batteries and items containing batteries)
- Lithium batteries
- All Liquids
- Aerosol cans (e.g. hair spray & deodorants)
- Alcohol
- Magnets & Magnetic material
- Speakers, Headphones, Earphones (they all have magnets)
- Barometers
- Mercury (Thermometers with mercury)
- Chemicals
- Cigarette lighters
- Cleaning materials inc. Bleach, Disinfectants, Laundry Detergents Oven cleaners
- Essential oils (e.g. eucalyptus, tea tree)
- Firearms and ammunition
- Fireworks
- Gas cylinders (e.g. Camping gas)
- Glue (e.g. Flammable, quick drying)
- Hair colourants, Bleaches Peroxides
- Herbicides
- Insecticides
- Lighter fluid
- Live Plants
- Matches
- Nail Polish/Remover
- Perfume/Perfume products
- Polish
- Oxygen cylinders and any other compresses gas cylinders
- Paint
- Refrigerants ie Fridges, Electric Coolers, Air Conditioners.
- Solvents
- Toner (e.g. Photocopier)

Items not listed above that have similar properties are also excluded.
