| Important notes |   | <ul> <li>Shipper must be imperatively present in Mauritius at the time of customs clearance except if he is a diplomatic client.</li> <li>Original passport &amp; original permits are imperative for customs clearance.</li> <li>Passport Memo to be obtained by the shipper at the Passport and Immigration Office of Port Louis before arrival of the shipment (returning citizen Mauritian only).</li> <li>If goods belonging to a family of shipper (wife, husband and children) are loaded to a shipment: original passports, residential permits, wedding and birth certificates are imperative for customs clearance.</li> <li>Do not load on shipment: alcohol and pharmacy products.</li> </ul> | Always obtain green lights before loading. |
